# KS1 RE Planning – Autumn 1 (2023-2024) Creation: Who made the world? (Harvest)

#### Week 1

## Elicitation task to be completed

#### Created things have creators

LO - think about what the creator of the natural world might be like.

Look at some objects and see what pupils think their creators would be like.

Look at objects in the natural world, what do pupils think this creator would look like?

**Activity** – chn pick an object from the natural world and draw and describe what they think the creator of it would look and be like.

#### Week 2

#### Creator of the world...God

LO - retell the story of Genesis 1.

Set the scene for Genesis 1 – a story that tells Christians and Jews about God.

Use Steve Turners 'In the beginning'

**Activity** – create artwork for each day and retell the story to partner.

#### Week 3

### If Christians believe God made the world, what should they do?

<u>LO - understand Christians sometimes thank God through prayer. Write a thank you prayer.</u>

Discuss thanking God. Look at some 'thank you' prayers Christians might say about the world.

**Activity** – chn attempt to write their own thank you prayer.

Week 4	Link to last week (saying thank you) – grace before meals
	LO - discuss saying grace before a meal. Write a grace.
	Many Christians thank god before every time they eat. Look at different examples of these prayers and talk about why people say them. What difference does it make to how they live?  Activity – chn attempt to write their own grace.
Week 5	Harvest – where Christians traditionally thank God for Creation
	LO - think about what we are thankful and grateful for.
	Connect to school harvest celebration, church, idea of giving to those in need.
	Talk about what things the chn are grateful for and who they could thank (e.g. parents, friends, teachers, doctor etc.)
	<b>Activity</b> – chn write thank you comments and give them to the appropriate people.
Week 6  Application	What questions would you ask about living in an amazing world?
task to be completed	LO - discuss questions we would want to ask a word creator.
completed	Recall the story from Genesis 1.
	If there was a Creator and word-maker you could ask, what questions would you have?
	<b>Activity</b> – class discussion of key question and then chn write some of their questions.
